

CR Band Parents' Association Meeting

Golf Tournament – Ken Hoffmann advised that the golf tournament is still on schedule, and we are still signing up foursomes and sponsors. Information is on the website. Volunteers will be needed to help work the tournament.

Points – Ken Hoffmann advised that points are still being earned and will be carried over to next year. Parents have the option next year to use points earned for the little trip or roll them over to the big trip year. Mr. Sandlin – Mr. Sandlin advised that all students travelling to Florida have received an information booklet and the rules and expectations were discussed in detail with them. There will be no marching rehearsal on Monday, February 8th. All-State Jazz concert went well on January 23rd. The All-State concert was at Salesianum on January 30th and also went well. We had 14 students participate in that concert. The Sound of Music is scheduled for March 4th, 5th, and 6th. About a dozen students are participating in the Pit Bulls to provide the music for the show. County band concert is coming up as are the May performances.
